Extension applications must be submitted on or before Friday, 30 April 2021.

Skills Development Facilitators are reminded that the reporting periods are as follows:

- Mandatory grant applications
 - The annual training report will be for the period 1 January to 31 December 2020 and the workplace skills plan will be for the period 1 January to 31 December 2021.
- Discretionary grant applications
 - The application for consideration for discretionary grant period is 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022.
